



Course Title: Arabic Language Level 2 (Part 2 of 2) - TEACHING MEDIUM: Arabic & English

Course Faculty: Arabic Language

Course Description:

This level is for students who have completed all contents in the Arabic Language Madinah Book 2 Part 1 (first 15 chapters) or equivalent. This part of the course will be continuing from chapter 16 of Madinah Book 2 and completing the full book by the end of the term

Course Overview:

In this course you will learn the following:

- The use of the relative particle 'Maa'
- The accusative forms of irregular nouns
- The names of colours when describing feminine nouns
- The differences in vowelings for diptotes and triptotes
- The accusative (Mansub) form of verbs
- The use of particles for emphasis
- How to negate imperfect verbs (in the Mudari' tense)
- The dual form in the accusative (Mansub) and genitive (Majrur) cases
- The particles of Jazm, Lam and Lamma and their uses
- The declension (I'raab) of nouns in their plural form
- All the rules regarding the numbers
- How verbs change in the present tense when there is a weak letter amongst them in their original past tense form
- The sevenfold classification of the verb
- The singular, dual and plural forms of adjectives



Course Duration:

This course is taught over a 3 month period, each week's lesson consists of 3 hours class time.

Course Materials:

You will be provided with a course pack consisting of Madinah Book 2 (if you have not already received a copy the previous term) from which you will primarily be taught. You should also bring a notepad and pen to take notes.

Homework:

For 3 hours of class work you will need to do at least 2 hours of homework and revision each week. As you will be learning new words and new grammar rules every week, it is highly recommended that you maintain two separate vocabulary and grammar notebooks to supplement you class notes.

Examinations:

The final examination for what you will have learnt throughout Arabic Language Level 2 takes place on week 11, this consists of a 90 Minute written paper, your final mark determines if you will be able to continue on to the next level. The pass mark for this course is 60%.

Certificates:

You will receive an in-house certificate recognizing your achievement in this course.
