

Course Title: Arabic Language Level 5 (Part 1)- **TEACHING MEDIUM:** Fully Arabic

Course Faculty: Arabic Language

Course Description:

This course is designed for those who have completed the Madinah books or equivalent and are ready to begin their Islamic Studies via the Arabic language focusing on Tawhid, Hadith and basic Fiqh. Future levels will focus on other subjects such as Arabic literature and poetry with all levels gradually increasing in difficulty. It is also recommended that you complete the Spoken Arabic Courses (Parts 1 and 2) before starting this course.

Course Overview:

In this course you will learn the following:

- The importance of Tawhid, its definition and categories
- The types of intercession
- Definition of Shirk and categories
- Disbelief and Hypocrisy: their definitions and categories
- Hadith regarding faith and being steadfast
- Hadith regarding the disbelief of one who abandons the prayer
- The virtue of the remembrance of Allah
- Hadith about love for the Messenger of Allah (pbuh)
- The virtue of good character
- The virtue of shyness
- The virtue and Fiqh of Friday prayers
- The Fiqh of the two Eid prayers
- The Fiqh of the eclipse prayer
- The Fiqh of the prayer for rain
- The Fiqh of funerals and the funeral prayer
- Basic introduction to the Fiqh of Zakah
- A vocabulary list of approximately 300 new words



Course Duration:

This course is taught over a 3 month period, each week's lesson consists of 3 hours class time.

Course Materials:

You will be provided with a course pack consisting of a book covering topics in Tawhid, Hadith and Fiqh derived from the study materials taught at the prestigious Muhammad Ibn Saud University (Saudi Arabia).

Homework:

For 3 hours of class work you will need to do at least 2 hours of homework and revision each week. As you will be learning new words every week, it is highly recommended that you maintain a separate vocabulary notebook to supplement you class notes.

Examinations:

A mock exam will take place on week 11 testing what you have learnt thus far; this is just to monitor your progress and does not affect your final mark. This exam will consist of both a written paper and an oral exam. The final examination takes place on week 11 of the next term when you complete Arabic Language Level 5 (Part 2).

Certificates:

There is no certificate given for this part of the course as this is level is split over two terms.
