

Course Title: Tajweed ul Qur'an Level 1

Course Faculty: Qur'an and Tajweed

Course Description:

This level is for students who are able to read Arabic and know the pronunciation (Makhraj) in detail. In this level students will start to add beauty to their recitation by learning certain fundamental rules of Tajweed; especially the nasal sounds. The following rules will be learnt in this course: Noon as Saakinah/Tanween, Meem as Saakinah, Laam as Saakinah and Qalqalah. Our aim in this course is to help students improve their recitation of the Qur'an and recite fluently with the rules learnt in class based on the Tajweed books by Shaykh Ayman and exclusively produced notes tailored for this level.

Course Overview:

In this course you will learn the following:

- The etiquettes of reciting the Qur'an
- What Tajweed means
- How to begin reciting from the beginning or middle of a Surah
- Learn exactly where the letters are articulated from
- The names of the places of articulation
- How to understand the difference between heavy sounds (Tafkheem) and light sounds (Tarqeeq)
- How to recite the name of Allah correctly
- The three types of Qalqalah
- The four rules of Noon as-Saakinah and Tanween
- The three rules of Meem as-Saakinah
- The rules Laam as-Saakinah
- Colour coding your own Tajweed rules Surahs

Course Duration:

This course is taught over a 3 month period, each week's lesson consists of 3 hours class time.



Course Materials:

You will be provided with our own specially designed Tayyibun Institute Tajweed ul Qur'an Level 1© course book from which you will primarily be taught. You should bring a notepad, pen to take notes and your own Mushaf (copy of the Qur'an) if you wish.

Homework:

For 3 hours of class work you will need to do at least 2 hours of homework and revision each week. As you are learning to read the Qur'an, it is recommended that you recite the Qur'an on a regular basis as much as possible.

Examinations:

A mock exam (testing theory only) will take place on week 7; this is just to monitor your progress and does not affect your final mark. The final examination consisting of theory and recitation takes place on week 11, your final mark determines if you will be able to continue on to the next level. The pass mark for this course is 50%.

Certificates:

You will receive an in-house certificate recognizing your achievement in this course.
